8. How was Ahaziah, king of Judah, related to the Israelite royal family? Who were Ahaziah's counselors? (2 Kings 8:25-27; 2 Chron. 22:1-5)
9. Who did Jehu kill and have killed? (2 Kings 9:14-28, 30-33; 10:1-27)

  - e) Jehoshaphat (Judah) (1 Kings 22:42-43)
  
  - f) Jehoram, or Joram (Judah) (2 Kings 8:16-18)
  
  - g) Ahaziah (Judah) (2 Kings 8:26-27)
