Timeline & Foreign Kings

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930 - Kingdom divided, Jeroboam's idolatry in Israel

930 - Division into Israel & Judah

895 - Some Israelites moved to Judah during Asa's reign

879 - Omri moved capital to Samaria

c. 870 - Ahab brought Baal worship into Israel

841 - Jehu killed Jezebel & Joram (Israel) & Ahaziah (Judah)

c. 800 - Jonah preached to Nineveh

c. 760 - Amos preached to Israel

c. 760 - Hosea preached to Israel

c. 750 - Micah preached concerning Israel & Judah

c. 740 - Isaiah began preaching

736 - Syro-Ephraimite War (Syria & Israel attacked Judah)

732 - Assyria conquered Damascus, exiled northernmost part of Israel

c. 725 - Hezekiah's reforms in Judah, some Israelites moved to Judah

721 - Assyria conquered and exiled Samaria

c. 712 - Assyria invaded Judah, Hezekiah paid tribute

711 - Assyria conquered Philistia, controlled Mediterranean coast to Egypt

701 - Assyrian army camped around Jerusalem but was destroyed by God

681 - Sennacherib assassinated in Nineveh

680-670 - Assyria resettled Israel, Samaritans mixed

671 - Assyria conquered Egypt

626, 614, 612, 609, 605 - Babylon & Media defeated Assyria

Tiglath-Pileser III – 745-727 BC

Sargon II – 722-705 BC

Sennacherib – 705-681 BC

Esarhaddon – 681-669 BC

Kings of Syria (Aram-Damascus)

Ben-Hadad I – 885-865 BC

Ben-Hadad II (Hadadezer) – 865-842 BC

Hazael – 842-796 BC

Ben-Hadad III – 796-792 BC

Unknown – 792-754 BC

Rezin II – 754-732 BC
